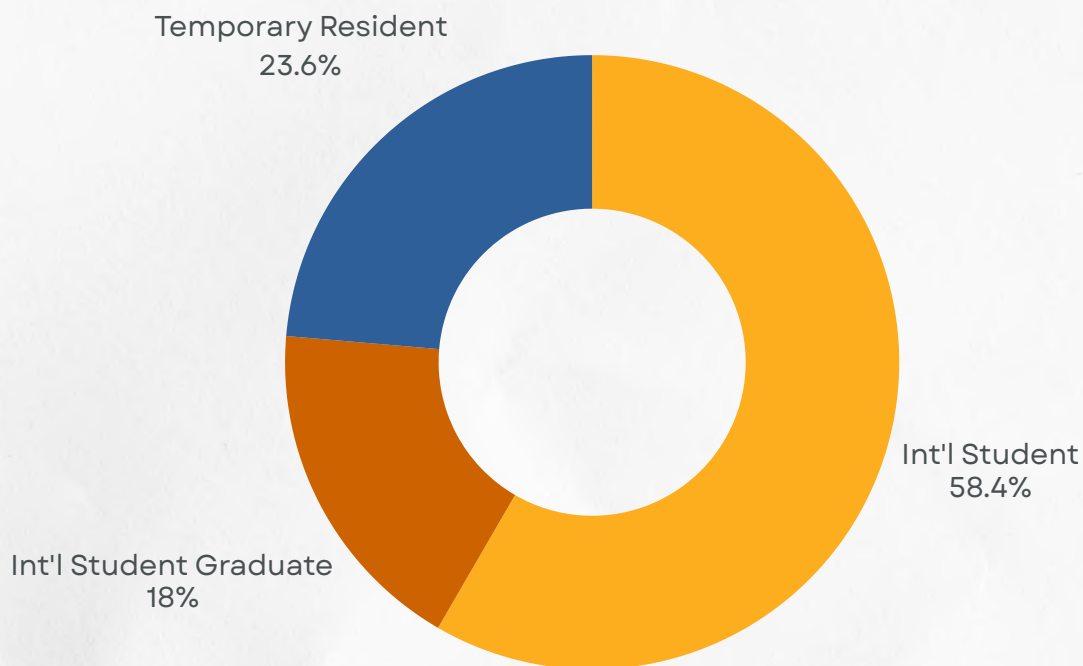




Target Audience
